

## Instructions for assembling the tree

1. Print out the two sheets on cardstock.
2. Cut out the rectangle around each tree along the black lines.
3. Score along the green lines.
4. Fold each in half along the green line, and glue shut.
5. Once the glue is dry, cut the trees closer to the trunk and branches, so that there is little white left around them.
6. Cut out the slit in each tree. One tree should have a slit on the bottom half, and the other should have one on the top half.
7. The two trees will now fit together. If they don't quite fit together, you can lengthen or widen one slit.
8. Use tape at the seams to keep the two parts of the tree from sliding apart. This is especially important on the trunk.
9. OPTIONAL: Use green clay to create a one-inch base for your tree: Shape the clay into something roughly one inch across, and use a straightened jumbo paperclip to press an "X" into the clay. Let the clay dry (or bake it, depending upon the type of clay). This will add stability and weight to the tree.

For easy transport, you can fold the trees flat. Make lots to create a 3D forest for your battle map!

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
